

## **BBHE Adverse Weather Contingency Plan**

### **Rain/Heavy Rain**

In the event that there is rain, the deployment of a gazebo is recommended but must adhere to the BBHE Gazebo Policy.

### **Wind/Strong Wind**

In the event of heavy wind, a judgement shall be made on the day. If the wind is above 20mph, the use of gazebos is prohibited.

### **Snow**

All efforts should be made to make the venue space safe. Snow should be cleared and grit salt scattered heavily over the venue space. For heavy snow, the event shall be cancelled.

### **Ice**

If ice is present, grit salt should be scattered heavily over the venue floor. The floor should then be assessed for grip. If the conditions do not improve, the event will be cancelled.

### **Suspended protection from severe weather**

If suspended protection (e.g. tarpaulin) is used, it should be appropriately secured to permanent structure(s) with wire and/or rope through every eyelet. In the event of snow, the use of tarpaulin is prohibited.
